The RFP states that PRDE was awarded \$589M in Restart funding, which is for this project and others, but they also ask for the right to terminate for their convenience or to protect the public interest (Section 9 (a)) and they include a non-appropriation clause (Section 34). In US Federal leases, the lease terms are described as base years and option years that equal the full term (i.e., a 3-yr lease is described as a base term and 2 one-year options), with the options being contingent on future appropriations. In the current scenario, we need to understand if the DOE funding is fixed or contingent (and if contingent, contingent on what?) and what portion of the total funding is being allocated to this PC project?</p>
