



**ADDENDUM NO 1
TO PRDE RFP NO: PRDE-OSIATD-FY2018-001 MOBILE DEVICE TECHNOLOGY
AND SERVICES FOR NEW GENERATION SCHOOLS**

CLARIFICATIONS AND AMENDMENTS

1. **Section V.1 (Proposal (Bid) Bond)** of the RFP is amended to read as follows: "Proposers are required to include a proposal guaranty (bid) bond in an amount equal to 15% of proposer's pricing for the first year of the lease."
2. **Repairs [Ticket System] on P. 19** requires vendors to have a local repair center in at least four (4) sites throughout the Island. This section is amended to read as follows: "Have a local repair center in one (1) or more sites throughout the Island, provided the number of repair sites proposed by proposer is sufficient to service all of the Department's schools and for the proposer to meet SLA response time requirements."
3. **Configuration, Delivery & Deployment Services on P. 16** requires vendors to have the ability to warehouse/store 2,500 to 3,500 devices for 10 months until deployed. This requirement is deleted due to the fact that that all of the devices are expected to be distributed by October 31, 2018.
4. **Cart Services on P. 20** requires vendors to have the ability to warehouse/store 150 to 250 carts for 10 months until deployed. This requirement is deleted due to the fact that all of the carts are expected to be distributed by October 31, 2018.
5. **Section V.9.A (Termination for Convenience or to Protect the Public Interest)** allows PRDE to terminate an agreement for convenience or to protect the public interest, without penalty for early termination, upon 30 calendar days' written notice. The last sentence of this section reads as follows: "In either instance, the Department will not pay any early termination charges under the lease." This sentence is deleted to permit the selected vendor(s) and PRDE to negotiate under what circumstances, if any, penalties may apply if the lease is terminated for a reason other than cause.
6. **Section 2.3.1 Minimum Device Specifications: Laptops (Cameras) on P. 11.** Line item 19 is amended to read as follows as follows to make world facing cameras optional for laptops: "1.0 MP front-facing and optional world facing cameras."



7. **Section 2.3.1 Minimum Device Specifications; Laptops (Screen Resolution) on P. 11.** Line item 22 is amended to permit 1366 X 768 resolution by modifying the display requirements to read as follows: “Display - 11.6-inch diagonal multi-touch capacitive touch display capable of operating with the attached keyboard - 1080 x 800 or 1366 x 768 minimum resolution or better.”
8. **Section 2.3.1 Minimum Device Specifications; Laptops (Ports) on P. 11.** Line item 24 is amended to make the RJ-45 port optional, and shall read as follows: “Input/output interfaces for video, keyboard, computer, audio and capable of connecting to standard video output devices such as digital projectors, smart boards, computer monitors, and TVs (additional detail under “Ports and Print Service”). At minimum, the device must include the following ports:
 - 2 USB (at least one of which is USB 3.0)
 - 1 HDMI
 - 1 3.5-mm stereo headphone mini-jack
 - 1 RJ-45 (Optional)”
9. **Section 2.3.1 Minimum Device Specifications; Tablets (Cameras) on P. 12.** Line Item 8 is amended to read as follows to make world facing cameras optional for tablets: “1.0 MP front-facing and optional world facing cameras.”
10. **Section 2.3.1 Minimum Device Specifications; Tablets (Screen Size) on P. 12.** The RFP is amended to insert a new line item 14 to read as follows: “Minimum tablet screen size is 7.9 inches.”
11. **Section 2.3.1 Minimum Device Specifications; Tablets (Battery Life) on P. 12.** The RFP is amended to insert a new line item 14 to read as follows: “Rechargeable battery - eight-hour battery capacity that will allow the device to be used throughout a standard school day with the wireless antenna activated without being recharged.”
