(Narrator): These are the English Listening Practice Questions for **3rd** grade. With these practice questions, you will show how well you can understand spoken English. Listen carefully. Then, mark the letter of the correct answer on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Look for question number 1.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Listen carefully to the following sentences. Choose the sentence that is correct. Mark the letter of the correct answer on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Note: Pause 2 seconds between options.)

(Narrator):

A	I have ever read this is the best book!
B	The best book I have ever read this is!
C	This is the best book I have ever read!

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Choose the letter of the correct answer and mark it on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Listen to the sentences again.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator repeats the sentences.)

(Pause 5 seconds.)

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(Narrator): Look for question number 2.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Listen carefully to the following sentences. Choose the sentence that is correct. Mark the letter of the correct answer on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Note: Pause 2 seconds between options.)

(Narrator):

A	The new teacher is very nice.
B	Very nice the new teacher is.
C	The new teacher very nice is.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Choose the letter of the correct answer and mark it on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Listen to the sentences again.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator repeats the sentences.)

(Pause 5 seconds.)

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(Narrator): Listen to a short conversation. You will answer questions 3 and 4 based on this conversation.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Girl): Did you see all the stars in the sky tonight, Mom? I made a wish on the first one I saw.

(Mother): I did too, María. On a dark night, you can see about 2000 stars in the sky. With a powerful telescope, you could see millions and millions of stars.

(Girl): Are there really that many up there?

(Mother): Oh yes. In fact, astronomers believe that our galaxy alone has more than 100 billion stars, and many of them are as big as the sun!

(Girl): Think of all the wishes you could make then!

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Now answer the following questions.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

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(Narrator): Look for question number 3. Now listen to the question.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): What question does the conversation answer?

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Note: Pause 2 seconds between options.)

(Narrator):

A	What do stars look like?
B	Why are there stars?
C	How many stars are in the sky?

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Choose the letter of the correct answer and mark it on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

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(Narrator): Look for question number 4. Now listen to the question.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): What is the conversation MAINLY about?

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Note: Pause 2 seconds between options.)

(Narrator):

A	making wishes on stars
B	counting the stars in the sky
C	sharing information about stars

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Choose the letter of the correct answer and mark it on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Listen to the conversation, the questions, and the answer choices again.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Characters repeat the conversation, and Narrator repeats the questions and the answer choices.)

(Pause 5 seconds.)

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(Narrator): Look for question number 5. Now listen to the question.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Female): Who will walk the dog?

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Which sentence answers the question correctly?

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Note: Pause 2 seconds between options.)

(Narrator):

A	Simon will walk the dog.
B	Walk the dog tomorrow night.
C	The dog is playing outside.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Choose the letter of the correct answer and mark it on your answer sheet.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Narrator): Listen to the question and the answer choices again.

(Pause 3 seconds.)

(Female repeats the question, and Narrator repeats the prompt and the answers.)

(Pause 10 seconds.)
