(Narrator): These are the English Listening Practice Questions for 6th grade. With these practice questions, you will show how well you can understand spoken English. Listen carefully. Then, mark the letter of the correct answer on your answer sheet.

(Ms. Ramírez): Class, today we're going to play math baseball. This will be a fun activity for you to practice adding and subtracting in your head.

There will be two teams, just like in real baseball. I will give addition or subtraction problems to players in the first team up to bat. The player at bat will have three minutes to solve the problem. I will use a timer to track how long you have. If the person at bat solves the problem before the timer rings, he or she will have scored a home run. If the person at bat does not solve a problem after three tries, that person will be out. Three outs and the next team gets a chance to go up to bat.
(Man): The teacher then divided the class into two teams, with an even number of boys and girls on each team. The teams were called the Porpoises and the Parrots. They stood on opposite sides of the classroom, and Ms. Ramírez began giving one addition or subtraction problem at a time to team members. She had written them on large cards, which she held up, so that the person at bat could look at the problem and try to solve it. As each team member answered the problem, either correctly or incorrectly, the score was kept on the board. When the game was over, the Parrots had won by three home runs.
